



Student Legal Services Fee F.A.Q.

What is the Student Legal Services Fee?

Eligible Ohio State students are automatically enrolled in the SLS legal services plan in the first term of their enrollment for the year.

How much is the fee?

The fee is an annual fee, which is charged to student in student's first term of enrollment at OSU. The amount of the fee depends on the student's first term of enrollment.

| QUARTER SYSTEM - First term of Enrollment | FEE |

How do students opt-out? How to opt-out depends on when a student is trying to opt-out.

Student may opt-out directly through Buckeyelink if:

- Student meets SLS plan eligibility requirements (main campus, non-distance learning, degree seeking, non-employee, etc.)
- Fees have posted to student's account
- The deadline has not passed to pay fees (i.e. it is not after the 7 day mark before classes begin for the term)

What if student doesn't see a choice to opt-out through Buckeye link?

If student does not see a choice to opt-out through Buckeyelink that may mean:

- Student does not meet SLS plan eligibility requirements and will not be charged
- It is the student's first term of enrollment, but fees have not yet posted to student's account
- It is the student's first term of enrollment, but the deadline to pay fees has passed
- It is not the student's first term of enrollment
