What is Student Legal Services (SLS)?

SLS is a team of legal professionals providing a legal services plan to eligible Ohio State students.

What types of services does SLS provide?

SLS services consist of court representation, personal advising sessions, informational brochures, sample document drafting, and a variety of educational programs.

What types of law does the SLS legal services plan cover?

SLS's scope of services includes Landlord-Tenant disputes, criminal misdemeanors, consumer transactions, traffic offenses, uncontested domestic matters, simple document drafting, and other miscellaneous matters.

What are the limitations of the SLS plan?

Which students are eligible for the SLS plan?

- Student must be a degree seeking OSU student attending main campus.
- Student must be enrolled in at least one non-distance learning class.
- Student's primary role with OSU must be as a student, not an employee.
